What? This spring's module is *Climate Change: The Future is Now*. This module engages participants in a variety of investigations to help establish basic understandings regarding climate science literacy. Exploration through both virtual and real-time experiments, the use of web based applications, modeling and engineering experiences will help students identify the facts, issues, and actions they wish to take.

How do I know if Fusion is for me?

Fusion is for any 4th and 5th grade student who...

- is very interested in science, math, and the environment,
- wants to learn about climate change,
- likes to find creative solutions to problems,
- can cooperate well in a team of different students, and
- will be committed to coming to meetings (your team will be relying on you!)

When? Mondays after school, 3:20 to 5:00, January 22nd to April 8th, 2024 (10 sessions).

Where? Seventh Avenue School

- We will have a bus from the elementary schools to Seventh Ave.
- If needed, a bus will be available to bring you back to your home afterwards.

How? Do **TWO things** so we know you are interested and committed:

1. Fill out the **commitment form** attached to this letter. Return it to your classroom teacher, or email it to sstaqaman@d105.net.
2. Tell us why you want to be a part of this IMSA Fusion Climate Change: The Future is Now program. You can explain your reasons and show us your excitement in any of the following ways:

 - create a poster
