- 5. Today starts Hispanic Heritage month and will go until October 15th. Tomorrow September 16th will be Mexican Independence Day. Mexico used to be called New Spain but it separated from Spain on September 16th 1810 and renamed itself to the current name of Mexico. Some of the causes of the separation was that Spain was forcing the indigenous population to work as "encomendados" a form of slavery, raised the taxes of the citizens of New Spain and would not allow it's Criollo population to participate in its political structures. The priest Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla brought all of the indigenous and criollo population in arms against the Spanish monarchy on the night of September 15th 1810 where it has become known as the scream of independence.

Hoy comienza el mes de la Herencia Hispana y continuara hasta el 15 de octubre. Manana 16 de septiembre sera dia de la independencia Mexicana. Mexico se llamaba Nueva Espana, pero se separo de Espana el 16 de septiembre de 1810 y se rebautizo con el nombre actual de Mexico. Algunas de las causas de la separacion fue que Espana obligaba a la poblacion indigena a trabajar como "encomendados" una forma de esclavitud, elevo los impuestos de los ciudadanos de Nueva Espana y no permitio que su poblacion criolla participara en sus estructuras politicas. El sacerdote Miguel Hidalgo y Costilla trajo toda la poblacion indigena y criolla en armas contra la monarquia espanola en la noche de 15 de septiembre de 1810 donde se ha convertido en el grito de independencia.
