Multiple norming windows and season comparisons

- From 2013 to 2024
 - three (3) norm periods
 - fall-spring comparison
 - spring to spring comparison
 - pandemic

NWEA 2020 norms

- Norms figured using pre-pandemic data
- Norms used for FY22, FY23, FY24 Achievement and Growth analysis
- NWEA caution - comparison of scores prior to July 2020
- New norming study occurring next school year

FY24 Year-End Progress Results

Percentage Meeting/Exceeding Individual Targets


- Math and Reading spring-spring progress results are down from last year.
- 64% met/exceeded Math growth targets - Met district target
- 58% met/exceeded reading growth targets - Did not meet district target
- NWEA - Approx. 60%-65% of students meeting growth targets = high performing district

National Ranking

- Overall national ranking for progress down from rolling average
- Ranking improves as more students EXCEED (not just meet) annual growth targets





FY24 Year-End Achievement Results

Achieving at/above 50th Percentile

- Percentage of students at/above 50th percentile is consistent with last spring in both Math and Reading
 - 66% achieved at/above 50th percentile in reading
 - 69% achieved at/above 50th percentile in math
 - Below district achievement target of 75% in both math and reading.


Achievement Gap – 35%

- Between our students of lower SES and those that are not
- Between our students that are Hispanic and those that are not

National Ranking

- Above 80th percentile ranking in both reading and math.
- Rankings surpass rolling average rankings in both reading and math.
- Rankings improve with HIGHER average RIT scores across grade levels




Math Achievement by Cohort

3rd, 4th, 5th Grade Cohorts




Math Achievement by Cohort

6th, 7th, 8th Grade Cohorts




Reading Achievement by Cohort
