Program Delivery: Gurrie Middle School

Two Co-Teaching EL Teachers at Gurrie

- One co-teaches 7th & 8th grade Math and Science
- One co-teaches 7th & 8th grade ELA and Social Studies
- Both have Flex periods to provide additional EL support

Student Placement & Support

- Students are placed in classes based on ACCESS proficiency levels
- Support is aligned to language needs and ACCESS scores
- Transition meetings help determine appropriate services

Program Delivery: Elementary Schools

Co-Teaching and English Language Development (ELD) Support for Elementary Students (Levels 1-4)

Co-Teaching Across Subjects:

Teachers collaborate across various subjects based on schedule availability.

The primary goal is co-teaching for writing, but teachers also co-teach in other subjects as needed.

Level 1 and Level 2 Support:

Students receive Pull-Out Services for English Language Development (ELD).

Level 1: 30 minutes per day

Level 2: 30 minutes per day

Newcomer Students:

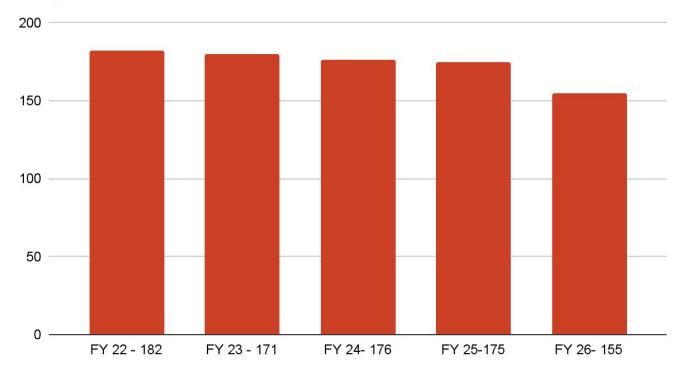
Receive 60 minutes daily of pull-out services focused on ELD.

Services decrease to 30 minutes daily as they progress.

Level 3 and Level 4:

Focus on co-teaching for ELD and subject integration, with an emphasis on writing support.
