


Survey Says Seventh Avenue School Is Well-Organized



The overall performance score is comprised of each of the 5Essential scores. Schools that are at or above benchmark on 3 or more essentials are 10 times more likely to improve than schools that are below the benchmark.



3rd - 6th Grade Students Reported....

I feel safe with my teachers at this school - 99% agree/strongly agree

I feel safe around the school: 91% agree/strongly agree (classes 100%, hallways 95%)

That their school peers treat each other with respect - 87% agree/strongly agree

I work hard to do my best in class - 95% agree/strongly agree

Some Of The Ways We Meet Our Students' Social Emotional Needs

- Daily Morning Assemblies
- Monthly social emotional school-wide focus and lessons
- SEL yearlong plan (consistency for staff)
- Positive reinforcement (monthly school-wide behavior focus areas)
- Sensory tools available
- Zones of Regulation lessons and tools
- Common teacher language (3B's Voice Levels, Hallway expectations, 3B's Be Respectful, Be Safe, Be Here & Ready)
- Lunchroom & recess incentives
- PTO & parent support
