

science. We also got to learn lots about the Cubs from Ms. Folliard and their amazing win.


And last but definitely not least to our sixth grade teachers, Ms. Waterston and Mrs. Wanta, thank you so much for teaching us

A BAT CHANGE IN LITTLE LEAGUE

Starting January 1, 2018 Little League Baseball, PONY Baseball, Babe Ruth Baseball, and many other leagues will want baseball/softball players to start using wood or composite bats. The bats must be marked with a USAbat symbol. According to USAbat, the elasticity of metal bats is greater than one of a wood bat.

As a player myself I think this change could be okay. I feel as

if games would go by more quickly because of players striking out faster. There would probably be less slaughters (beating someone so much that the game is over), too. I own a wooden bat, and my advice is to go to the batting cages every week and practice with it. When I got my wood bat it felt really weird because the bat was so heavy. You have to get used to the weight.

If you want to buy a wood



bat wait until September because that is when they will start to produce bats with the USAbat symbol. If you are on travel team you may still use bats that are not marked with the symbol. Players 14 and under, use this rule. This does not include t-ball.



HOW TO MAKE PICTURES WITH GOOGLE DRAWINGS

1. Go into Google Drawings. To do this, you must go into a Google Document, press "Insert", then "Drawing..."

2. Basically, you can do anything here that your heart desires. I will tell you a few of my tricks of why I love Google Drawings in the following instructions.

3. I like making cool titles. One of the ways I do this, is by putting an image under my text. I just use a picture that fits my theme, and put a text box over it, saying my title or whatever I want it to say.

4. Another way I make cool versions of my text is by layering. I take a text box, and make it what I want it to say. 


4. Isoflex Stress Balls





LEGEND BY MARIE LU



We decided to attempt to keep our identities a secret (which really didn't work) because we felt that the students would trust us with their problems if they didn't know who they were asking help from. It didn't





really work because you guys are very smart and could easily put two and two together and figure out it was us.


