



- Spring-Winter Progress Analysis = students meeting approximately ½ annual target
- Not an official MAP target

#### Spring 2024-Winter 2025 Overall Progress


→ Both Math and Reading FY25 progress results are <u>at or above highest progress</u>


Typical Annual Growth and Stretch Annual Growth

  - Stretch Goal Key metric to examine since meeting annual stretch target addresses achievement gap

## Overall District Progress - <u>READING</u> Percentage of students meeting or exceeding winter growth targets MAP 2025






#### Winter Overall Achievement






# Mid Year 2024-2025 Student Achievement COHORTS




# Winter FY25 MAP MATH Achievement COHORTS %ile At or Above Grade Level




# Winter FY25 MAP MATH Achievement COHORTS %ile At or Above Grade Level
